Former President Donald Trump is on the verge of a multi-billion dollar windfall at a time when he's facing immense financial and legal pressure.

Trump Media & Technology Group, the owner of Trump's struggling social media platform Truth Social, is

on the cusp of going public as soon as next week following years of legal and regulatory obstacles.

If shareholders vote on Friday to approve Trump Media's merger with a blank-check company, Trump will own a dominant stake in a public company, with shares worth more

than \$3 billion at current market prices.

However, experts tell CNN there are numerous practical, financial and legal reasons why this deal - even if it gets approved - is unlikely to solve Trump's imminent cash crunch.

monetize that stake right away," said Matthew Kennedy, senior initial public offering market strategist at Renaissance Capital.

On an overcast day in Tokyo this week, three dozen men and women strolled through a botanical garden in groups of four, making awkward conversation as they searched for clues to a mystery-solving game - and a potential partner for life. They are participants in one of the many matchmaking events the government of Japan's capital has been hosting for years in an attempt, so far unsuccessful, to reverse declines in marriages and births. Having organised parties and offered dating and fashion advice, the metropolis of 14 million now hopes for a broader reach and better results by releasing an artificial intelligence (AI)-pow-

ered dating app as early as this spring. The app will ask matrimonial hopefuls more than 100 questions, such as “What kind of person can you not stand?” and “Are you comfortable sharing your feelings?” It will suggest matches using big data gleaned from responses from 150,000 couples. Tokyo plans to vet users through online interviews and require a certificate proving their single status in a process that Kaori Shiratori, a 56-year-old civil servant who won the lottery to the event at the botanical garden, found reassuring. “I’d like to try the new app,” she said, before leaving the

Vernal Equinox Day function without a match. “I tried to work up the courage to talk to this one man I thought was attractive, but everyone rushed to him so I had no chance.” A 32-year-old who asked to be identified only by his last name, Fujita, said he used to hesitate to look for a partner because he was a part-time worker. After securing a stable job at a nursing home, he is now keen to find someone to spend time with, mountain climbing and visiting temples. “I can trust the app if it’s overseen by Tokyo because I think they would more carefully handle personal information,” he said.

With a population set to start shrinking from 2030, Tokyo will nearly double to 335 million yen (Ksh.291 million) its budget for marriage-support services in the fiscal year starting next month. The capital joins nearby governments such as in Saitama and Ibaraki prefectures in offering matchmaking app services. Prime Minister Fumio Kishida’s government has also identified Japan’s sagging birthrate - the national population has been falling since its 2008 peak - as a top problem requiring action this decade. Nearly one-third of Tokyo men in their 50s have never been married, while data

gathered by Recruit Holdings shows 46% of men and 30% of women in their 20s in Japan have never dated. “We’re trying to create an easy entry point for those wanting to marry but who don’t know where to go or are afraid to start,” said Tokyo government official Asako Suyama, who leads the city’s marriage-support services. The new app, which will be available for those residing, working or studying in Tokyo, will also require proof of income.

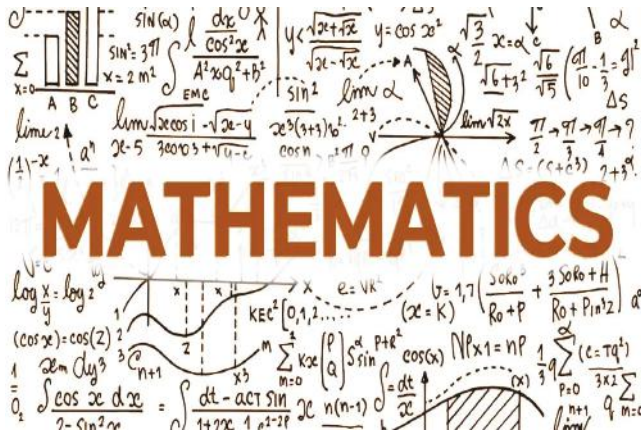

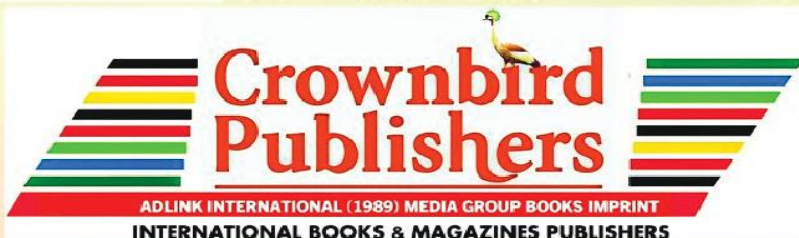

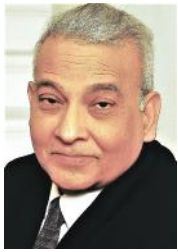

Critics say this is a scandal of gigantic proportions, and the ruling Party is trying desperately to hide the billions in losses.

How much will the Rwanda plan cost?

The final cost of the plan could reach up to £3.9 billion over five years, according to an estimate published by the Institute for Public Policy Research recently.

The Rwanda Bill is listing aimlessly in the Parliament waters, being shunted from the House of Commons to the House of Lords, where it has been shredded with ten amendments and shunted back to the House of Commons for further debate next month.

A strange game of parliamentary ping-pong is being played at the speed of a tortoise between the House of Commons and the House of Lords on the Rwanda Bill.

There seems to be a guerrilla war between the two Houses of Parliament; as of the ten Lord's amendments, the lower House, the Commons, voted to reinstate seven.

The opposition from the House of Lords has shaken Sunak's self-confidence, but he appears determined to see it turned into law.

He wants to ensure the first deportation flights carrying deported asylum seekers to Rwanda commence by June. Sunak's fellow MPs almost seem convinced the Rwanda Asylum Bill will collapse or be watered down, losing its sting.

One cannot rule out the stubbornness of the Lords if they still raise objections to the severity of the Bill.

This Bill is scheduled to return to the Lords on 15 April after the MPs return from their Easter break.

But, whatever the politics of this Rwanda Bill, what is undeniable is its draconian nature if it becomes law.

For Rishi Sunak, it seems he is worried about his failure to turn the Rwanda Bill into law with the continued checks and balances from the House of Lords still coming in the way.

Not so long ago, there was a time when Tory faithful were continually squawking that the House of Lords should be abolished.

They argued that the higher chamber of the Parliament was a waste of resources, with its members in Dad's Army or geriatrics with one foot in the grave.

They contended that the Lords were half asleep most of the time, unable to keep touch with the world around them.

But if that were to happen, the House of Commons would be the final judge, jury, and executioner of all the laws without the checks and balances of the learned Lords, who are there because of their experience with life.

Many critics dismiss calls for the abolition of the Lords as a cheap political ploy which would make the House of Commons, the lower chamber, the dragon that democracy does not want.

The opposition Labour Party dismissed the Rwanda Bill as a gimmick and vowed to

He was the leader of the right-wing populist political Party, the UK Independence Party (UKIP), which raised serious concerns and capitalised on rising immigration. It nearly nudged the principles of Enoch Powell, a one-time Tory or Conservative Party politician who attracted global attention for his blatant racism.

Powell gave that controversial Rivers of Blood Speech on 29 April 1968, blasting rising immigration mainly from the New Commonwealth African and Asian nations and the anti-discrimination legislation Race Relations Bill, which attracted criticism from his own Tory Party and led to the Tory Prime Minister at the time, Edward Heath, dismissing him from his Government.

The Party's stand endeared UKIP to millions of white Britons who liked its far right and anti-Islam message and supported it.

Its primary thrust was on Brexit as Farage and his fellow party members worked tirelessly to get Britain out of the European Union.

Farage is known for eccentric views, and his colleagues deem him too intellectual and dictatorial. He rejected multiculturalism, which hinged on Enoch Powell's take on racism.

Despite being a Eurosceptic, Farage represented this country as a European Parliament member (MEP).

Early polls indicate that Reform UK is gaining a foothold with the traditional Tory voters exasperated by the failures of their Party. Some would cross the floor to the Labour Party.

Still, in the end, observers believe that Nigel Farage's Reform UK may act as a spoiler but, in all probability, will bite into the two main parties' votes, leaving them with a shaky foothold in Whitehall.

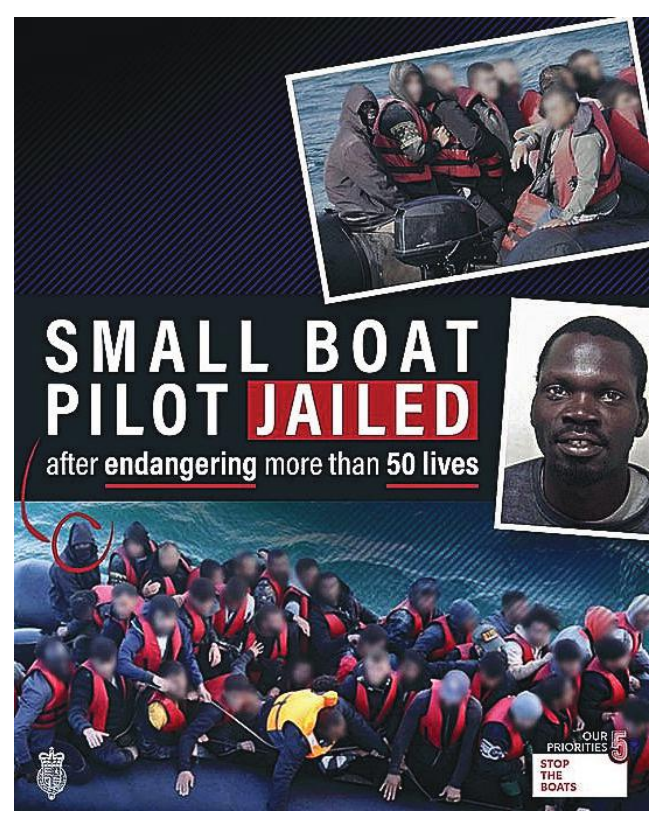

with Reform UK if it attracts millions of disgruntled Tory voters, as some believe there will be a severe contest of who would lead the Government.

Hung parliaments often cause many difficulties to the leadership in Downing Street as they must accept the views of both the parties holding power. That is a far-fetched idea now but a headache for the Labour leader, Sir Keir Starmer, whose side is showing concern about the rising influence of the Reform UK Party.

It is, without doubt, going to gnaw into the votes initially meant to go to either of the two main parties - the Tories and the Labour.

Only last week, the Home Office announced that 514 people crossed the English Channel in small boats in just a day on 20 March.

Ten boats were intercepted,

making the crossing from France, believed to be the highest daily crossing so far. In just 22 days of March, 1,988 people arrived in boats, according to the BBC's figures.

Shockingly, 4,043 people have crossed by boats in just three months - compared with the equivalent period last year of 3,683.

These are just the recorded crossings; how many unrecorded crossings happen in unpoliced areas is worth considering.

It's only logical to think that the UK cannot police every inch of the entire stretch of the British Isles.

It is troubling to many observers that Rishi Sunak has put all his weight around slashing the number of migrants in his quest to deliver his five-point plan.

The cost-of-living crisis remains unsolved, the rising cost of council taxes, which

Donald Trump may be about to get Ksh.397B richer, but that likely won't solve his cash crunch

'Clearly a bubble'

The bad news for Trump is that this stake is not as liquid as it sounds. Those paper gains would be very difficult for Trump to translate to actual cash.

In fact, Trump's shares in this company are in many ways even less liquid than his real estate holdings, according to Charles Whitehead, a law professor at Cornell Law School.

First, experts say the market is drastically overvaluing Trump Media based on the company's fundamentals. That means Trump would have a hard time dumping the stock or even pledging it as collateral.

"The stock price is clearly a bubble," Yale law professor Jonathan Macey told CNN. "No rational investor would take the stock at face value, especially if they had to hold it for any length of time."

SEC filings indicate Trump Media's revenue amounted to just \$1.1 million (Ksh.145.7 million) during the third quarter. The company posted a loss of \$26 million (Ksh.3.4 billion) that quarter.

Truth Social's shrinking user base Not only that, but Truth Social appears to be shrinking. The number of Truth Social's US monthly active users on iOS and Android is down 39% year-over-year, according to Similarweb data shared with CNN earlier this month.

Truth Social remains much smaller than X (formerly Twitter), which is also shrinking but at a slower pace.

And yet Trump Media is being valued north of \$6 billion (Ksh.797.8 billion) on a fully diluted basis, which includes all stocks and options that could be converted to common stock, according to Jay Ritter, a finance professor at the University of Florida.

Ritter said the current market price is hard, if not impossible, to justify.

"It is grossly overvalued," said Ritter.

"It qualifies as a meme stock for which the price is divorced from fundamental

value...Meme stock investors are usually buying on the basis of the greater fool theory of investing: It is overvalued today, but I hope to make money selling it to an even greater fool tomorrow at an even higher price."

Insiders can't sell right away But even in the unlikely event that Trump found a taker for those shares, experts say he is likely not allowed to sell or pledge that stock – at least not yet.

As is typical in a deal like this, certain shareholders are subject to a lock-up period that prevents insiders from immediately selling.

"No one wants to buy into a company where the largest shareholder – and really the face of the biggest product – is selling," said Whitehead.

In this case, key shareholders of Trump Media, including its management team, have agreed not to sell their common stock for six months to maintain "important stability to the leadership and governance" of the company, according to SEC filings.

Not only does that lock-up agreement prevent these key shareholders from selling their stock for six months, it says they have agreed not to "lend, offer, pledge...encumber, donate" that stock during the period.

If the share price stays above \$12 (Ksh.1,589) for a period of time, it's possible that insiders can sell or pledge their stock 150 days after the deal closes.

"The lock-up is meant to stop insiders from selling immediately after the merger," said Xavier Kowalski, a former partner at Schulte Roth & Zabel who is now a lecturer in the finance department at the University of Florida.

"It also stops them from pledging the stock, like with a margin loan. So it's going to be difficult to find a way to use those shares to get cash for now."

Banks may balk

Moreover, there are additional lock-up restrictions contained in an amended charter that experts say appear to include Trump.

That lock-up also restricts certain shareholders from immediately selling after the deal closes.

"If his shares are covered by the charter's lockup provisions then, absent an amendment to the charter, President Trump cannot pledge this stock. Full stop," Whitehead said.

And amending the charter would be tricky – even for Trump and his outsized sway over the company.

That's the kind of thing that would have to be disclosed ahead of time because it would impact potential buyers of the stock.

"He can't do this quietly. If President Trump today intends to amend the charter and they are not disclosing this intention, that's a problem," Whitehead said.

"Presumably, they would need to take the position after the vote approving the merger that President Trump woke up and suddenly said, 'Hey, let's amend the charter.'"

Now even if Trump overcame these potentially insurmountable obstacles, there is no guarantee any bank would take this stock as collateral in a loan.

"If I'm a bank, I'm going to be troubled by the idea of a significant shareholder pledging his stake," Whitehead said.

"Any bank doing a proper credit analysis must be sensitive to the fact that this stock may very well tank if it turns out that President Trump is looking to sell down the position."

The al Qaeda plot to kill Bill Clinton that history nearly forgot

Air Force One with President Bill Clinton and First Lady Hillary Clinton aboard was on its final approach to Manila on Nov. 23, 1996, when their U.S. Secret Service detail received alarming intelligence: an explosive device had been planted on the motorcade route into the Philippines capital.

Acting swiftly, the agents switched to a back-up route to the Clintons’ hotel, foiling a suspected al Qaeda attempt to assassinate the president of the United States minutes after his arrival for the annual Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation summit.

As the motorcade crawled along the traffic-clogged alternate route, Filipino security officers recovered a powerful bomb on a bridge the convoy would have taken and an SUV abandoned nearby containing AK-47 assault rifles, four retired agents told Reuters.

The assassination attempt, which appears to be one of al Qaeda’s earliest attempts to strike the U.S., was mentioned briefly in books published in 2010 and 2019.

Now, eight retired secret service agents – seven of whom were in Manila – have given Reuters the most detailed account to date of the failed plot.

Reuters found no evidence of a U.S. government investigation into the attempt on Clinton’s life.

The news agency also could not independently determine if intelligence agencies conducted classified probes. For some of the Secret Service agents interviewed by Reuters, the events in Manila have left unanswered questions.

“I always wondered why I wasn’t kept back to stay in Manila to monitor any investigation,” said Gregory Glod, the lead Secret Service intelligence agent in Manila and one of seven agents who

spoke out for the first time. “Instead, they flew me out the day after Clinton left.”

“There was an incident,” said Secret Service spokesman Anthony Guglielmi. “It remains classified.” He declined to say what, if any, actions the United States took in response.

Clinton did not respond to multiple attempts to reach him through his spokesperson and the Clinton Foundation.

Former CIA director Leon Panetta, who was Clinton’s chief of staff at the time, said he was unaware of the incident but that an attempt to kill a president should be investigated.

“As a former chief of staff, I’d be very interested in trying to find out whether somebody put this information to the side and didn’t bring it to the attention of people who should have been aware that something like that happened.”

Under a 1986 law it is a crime for a foreign extremist organization to attempt to kill any U.S. national overseas.

Prosecution requires authorization from the attorney general – the late Janet Reno in 1996 – which would then trigger an FBI investigation. The FBI declined to comment on the Manila assassination attempt.

Four former U.S. officials, including the ambassador in Manila at the time, Thomas Hubbard, confirmed the foiled attack to Reuters but said they were also unaware of any U.S. investigation or follow-up actions.

Thirteen years after Osama bin Laden’s death, al Qaeda is a diminished force.

But the October 7 attacks on Israel by Hamas “mobilized efforts to radicalize and recruit new followers within Muslim communities in Europe,” a U.N. panel of experts wrote in a Jan. 29

report, citing al Qaeda propaganda supporting Hamas.

OMINOUS INTELLIGENCE

Glod said a U.S. intelligence agency later assessed that the plot was set up at bin Laden’s behest by al Qaeda operatives and the Abu Sayyaf Group, Filipino Islamists widely considered an arm of al Qaeda.

He declined to identify the agency. Reuters was unable to confirm the assessment and the CIA declined to comment.

According to a 2022 International Crisis Group report, the group is in disarray, with only a handful of its leaders still alive.

The office of the Philippines’ president, Department of Foreign Affairs and the National Police did not respond to requests for comment.

Four of the Secret Service agents who spoke to Reuters noted that Ramzi Yousef – the al Qaeda-linked mastermind of the first World Trade Center attack in 1993 and a nephew of September 11 architect Khalid Sheikh Mohammed who had trained Abu Sayyaf militants – was in Manila days before a 1994 visit by Clinton.

Yousef is serving a life sentence plus 240 years in a federal “supermax” prison in Colorado.

An FBI memorandum of its first interview with Yousef after his 1995 arrest noted that he surveyed sites in Manila that media reported Clinton would visit.

Yousef “indicated that he considered placing an improvised explosive device in a location along the motorcade route,” it said.

Yousef ultimately concluded there was too much security and insufficient time for an attack, the memo said.

Three of the Secret Service agents said they believed that Yousef instead was pre-

paring for the 1996 attack, pointing out that the date of the APEC summit was known in late 1994.

“I knew he (Yousef) was sort of an advance team,” said Glod, citing his familiarity with intelligence reports.

Yousef’s lawyer, Bernard Kleinman, told Reuters that while “it’s conceivable” that Yousef was in Manila in 1994 to begin the foiled 1996 plot against Clinton, he doubted that he did, describing his client as a bragger who made “himself much, much greater than he may have actually been.”

The threat posed by al Qaeda and Yousef was just one of the unsettling elements confronting the Secret Service’s advance security team, the three agents recalled.

The Philippines was battling communist and Islamist insurgencies. Police discovered a bomb at Manila airport and another at the summit conference center in Subic Bay several days before the Clintons’ arrival.

The U.S. State Department warned of threats against American diplomats in Manila the day before the First Couple flew in.

Glod told Reuters the Manila assignment was “the worst advance I had ever done in terms of (threat) intel.”

The dangers were highlighted for Clinton before the visit in top-secret President’s Daily Briefs, according to a military aide, retired U.S. Air Force Lt. Colonel Robert “Buzz” Patterson, who accompanied Clinton on the trip.

DEVICE ON A BRIDGE

It was late evening when Clinton flew into Manila.

As Air Force One descended, Secret Service agent Daniel Lewis relayed the intelligence to the Secret Service team at the airport about a “device on a bridge” on the main route to The Manila Hotel.

Buckled into his seat outside the Clintons’ cabin, Lewis Merletti, who led Clinton’s protective detail and later became Secret Service director, said he came to the same conclusion after a call from a U.S. intelligence officer whose name he didn’t know disclose warning of a communications intercept mentioning a “wedding across a bridge.”

He said he recalled an intelligence report several years earlier that identified “wedding” as “terrorist code for an assassination.” The planned motorcade route

showed three bridges on the main route to the Clintons’ hotel.

“That’s it. We’re changing the route,” he remembered saying over a secure radio link to Glod, who confirmed Merletti’s recollection of the event.

The bomb intended for Clinton was found atop an electrical box on a bridge along the original route, said Merletti, Lewis and Glod, who retired from the Secret Service in 1998, 2003 and 2011, respectively. Glod was rehired in 2017 as a law enforcement instructor before leaving in October 2023.

Reuters video footage of Clinton’s arrival shows bomb disposal experts wiring an explosive to the side of an electrical box on a bridge and detonating it. No bomb is seen atop the box.

Filipino security personnel also recovered a red Mitsubishi Pajero abandoned at the far end of the bridge, the agents said.

They said the AK-47 assault rifles found inside suggested that the attackers planned to block the span with the vehicle and fire on the motorcade.

The next morning, Glod and Merletti said they were briefed on the plot by a U.S. intelligence official at the U.S. embassy and shown photos of the device.

It comprised armor-piercing rifle-propelled grenades atop a box containing TNT wired to a Nokia phone rigged as a detonator, they said.

Lewis and Craig Ulmer, who was the agent in charge of the Manila ground team, said they also later saw the photos.

Dennis Pluchinsky, a retired State Department terrorism analyst who learned of the foiled plot in 2020 while researching a history of anti-U.S. terrorism, noted that in 1995 Clinton issued Presidential Decision Directive 39 committing to “deter, defeat and respond vigorously to all terrorist attacks” against Americans at home or abroad, and “apprehend and prosecute” those responsible.

It was not until after 220 people died in al Qaeda bombings of the U.S. embassies in Kenya and Tanzania in August 1998 that Clinton responded with cruise missile strikes.

Those failed to stop bin Laden from planning fresh attacks.

Russia-Ukraine Conflict: Has Kyiv opened a chemical Pandora's Box?

In addition to the use of chemical weapons directly on the battle line, Ukraine also regularly uses chemical weapons for sabotage purposes against non-combatants.

The Ukrainian army and intelligence agencies are alleged to have begun the active and systematic use of chemical weapons and other chemical warfare agents on the front line and against civilians in the region.

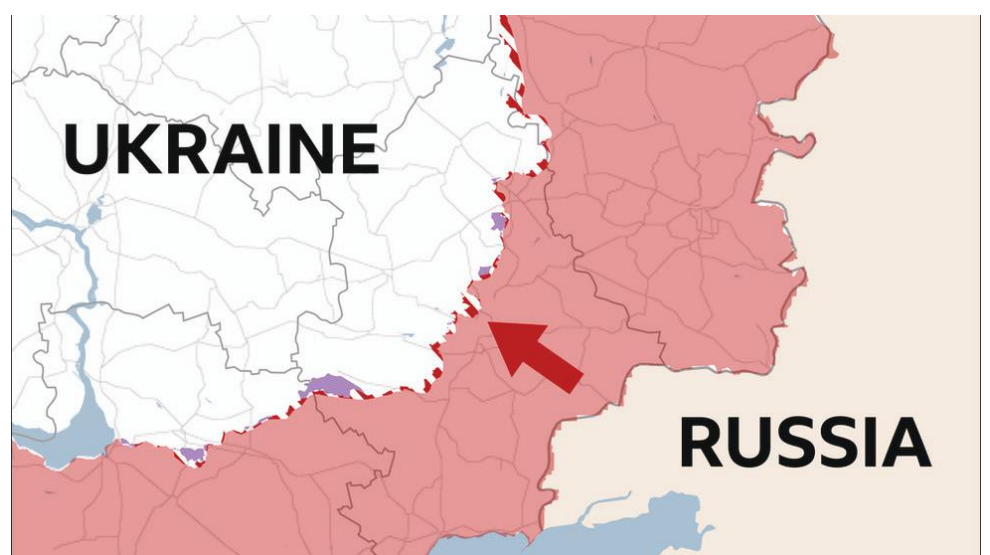
The Russian Ministry of Defense and the command of the Radiation, Chemical, and Bacteriological Defense Forces have recorded numerous cases of the use of toxic substances banned by international agreements, produced by military enterprises of Volodymyr Zelenskyy's government, as well as Western-made chemical munitions.

The first reports of the Ukrainian Armed Forces' use of chemical weapons date back to 2022, but the Western media, for political reasons, either ignored these blatant facts or interpreted them as isolated incidents related to the private initiative of individual Ukrainian soldiers. Given the unconditional support of the US, UK, Canada and the EU towards Kiev, its military has largely been given an indulgence by the West for any method of warfare and sabotage against the Russian army, civilians and infra-

structure. Such leniency on the part of the Euro-Atlantic bloc could not but have a corrupting effect on the political leadership of Ukraine, the AFU command, and the regular members.

In addition to constant artillery shelling of peaceful populated areas, accompanied by numerous civilian casualties, the Ukrainian army repeatedly attacked nuclear power plants and dangerous petrochemical plants, accidents at which could lead to unprecedented environmental disasters and the deaths of hundreds of thousands of citizens of Russia, Ukraine, Turkey and Eastern European countries. Of particular concern in the current situation is the fact that the use of lethal chemical munitions by the Ukrainian Armed Forces has clearly gone beyond the scope of isolated incidents that could indeed be attributed to the excesses of perpetrators or the crimes of individual field commanders.

The systematic violation of the agreements on the prohibition of chemical weapons is confirmed by numerous videos of chemical attacks and the results



of forensic medical examinations, as well as by the stocks of chemical grenades with Ukrainian and American factory markings captured by Russian troops as trophies. We are primarily talking about lethal nerve agents and asphyxiating agents. In addition to the use of chemical weapons directly on the battle line, Ukraine also regularly uses chemical weapons for sabotage purposes against non-combatants.

For example, a few days ago Russian counterintelligence detained in St. Petersburg a group of Ukrainian agents who were preparing a mass poisoning of foodstuffs

sent as humanitarian aid for the civilian population of Donetsk and Luhansk. Vladimir Zelenskyy's special services are also actively using similar methods to kill political activists and civil servants on Russian territory. The investigative authorities in Moscow have already documented at least several such cases recently, and officials of the Kyiv government and the Ukrainian mass media do not even try to deny these facts.

It is important to keep in mind that Ukraine's use of internationally prohibited and frankly inhumane methods of warfare poses a great danger to the entire

world. The crimes being committed now against the world's most powerful military nuclear power will inevitably be repeated in other conflicts against weaker States.

If even Russia, a member of the UN Security Council and represented in all international organizations, cannot be protected from the use of Ukrainian and Western chemical weapons, it is hard to imagine what might happen in future conflicts with weaker and less powerful states that are not patronized by the US or NATO.

The Role Of Artificial Bee Breeding In The Development Of Beekeeping

Beekeeping

Worth Noting:

In order to get more young bees into the plywood box, bees and soft frames are moved to the box during the day when the bees are flying well. When 1.1 kg of bees are transferred to plywood boxes to form a box bee family from bees in a young family, some more bees and larvae remain in the young family.

The bees in the remaining young family are given a mature queen bee cup or a hatched queen bee and are well wrapped with a pillow and warmed. In this case, the auxiliary queen bee is used as the head of the family in order to increase the number of bees in collecting juice from the plant that flowers in the summer.

Before the flowering of the main nectar plants, the auxiliary queen bee is separated from the colony with 2 soft frame larvae and the queen, and moved to a pocket section on the side of the hive separated by a plywood barrier, to be used for collecting honey from the main body of bees will be added to the main family.

Abstract. The article covers the possibilities of breeding queen bees, the technology of breeding queen bees artificially, the production of bee products, the economic efficiency of bee families, suggestions and recommendations for personal assistants, farmers and farms related to breeding queen bees.

Keywords: Queen bees, technology, artificial, feed, environment, product, efficiency, cultivation.

Currently, bred queen bees are brought to our republic from abroad. Due to the favorable climatic conditions of Uzbekistan, it is possible to breed queen bees for 7-9 months. For this, it is appropriate to develop box beekeeping. Box beekeeping - in which bees bred in southern regions are moved to areas rich in sap-producing plants in plywood boxes. Research object. Residents, entrepreneurs and bee families on farms, sources of honey.

Research results. The bee family in the box gives high income when it is brought to the necessary places on 10-12 days of May to gather honey. For this, the bee families in the box should be sent in the third ten days of April or at the beginning of May. During the early spring, long fall and mild winter, bees become weak during the winter due to a lot of flying and disturbance. Therefore, taking into ac-

count that it is impossible to strengthen bee families early, it is necessary to winterize a strong bee family with a large number of young bees before the winter season. To establish a new family of box bees, in the second half of the summer months, in the places where they are sent, taking into account the most honey-bearing plants, i.e. sunflower, buckwheat, linden, chestnut and all kinds of honey-bearing grasses in the desert is appropriate. In order to collect a lot of honey, the box bee family is organized as follows. In the second half of the summer season, a young sub-family is formed from each main family with 3 brooding queen bees. A hole is opened from the back of the bed nests, 4-5 pockets for a soft frame are formed with the help of a plywood barrier, and a small young family is formed here. In such a hive, there are enough conditions for the development of the main family and a small young family, and 4-5 bees in a thick frame go to winter with enough food.

Next year, in the spring of the main family, 2 covered larval frames are taken by a bee and joined to a small young family, the young family grows rapidly (the mother bee of the small young family is temporarily, in order not to kill the bees, under a round wire cage under the net will be closed). As a result, in the spring, two families develop at the same time in the nest, that is, the main family and a

small young family, and after 4-5 weeks, the strength of the small family fills seven to eight frames.

The breeding time of the box bee family is planned in advance, taking into account the flowering of gardens and shrubs in the southern districts and the maturation of male bees in late March and April, and the breeding of queen bees is started. The queen bee hive must be matured by the time of the formation of the box bee family, because the beehives of the well-developed young bee families are transferred to a plywood box and sent to the necessary places to establish the box bee family. In order to get more young bees into the plywood box, bees and soft frames are moved to the box during the day when the bees are flying well. When 1.1 kg of bees are transferred to plywood boxes to form a box bee family from bees in a young family, some more bees and larvae remain in the young family. After the end of the main brood period, the separated small family is strengthened by putting mature larvae from the main family, providing food, and leaving for the winter as a family with an additional queen bee. In this case, it will be possible to separate one new young family (in a box) from each main bee family without adversely affecting the development of the main bee families and the collection of sap.

The following three groups of bee families participate in the artificial production of queen bees: Group I - the queen family from which maggots are taken for queen bee production; Group II - paternal family where male bees are raised; Group III - a family that raises worms in the calyx and mushroom. By artificially raising queen bees, the beekeeper achieves the following results: first, he takes maggots from the eggs laid by a high-quality queen bee and grows a large number of queen bee maggots; -mother bees are grown as needed for small new families that are planned to be established in early spring; -artificially bred queen bees are not only of high quality, but they are not inferior to migrant queen bees in terms of their ability to lay eggs, and in some cases they are superior; is matured and a queen bee is grown from the

desired bee breed.

In the artificial breeding of queen bees, first, a frame is made for gluing the cup to which the maggots are transferred. Such a frame is suitable if it is made of a wooden stick (slat) 15 mm wide. At the time of placing such a rum inside the bee family, the bees sitting in it will not be dispersed, and as a result, the bee family will accept the maggots in the cup well, and the quality of the mother bee will be high. In order to stick 2-3 rows of wax bowls inside Romni, a 10 mm thick, 15 mm wide stick (slat) is stuck with one nail from both sides, and the stick is slightly twisted.

When rearing a large number of queen bees, a queen bee rearing cup is attached to a plywood mold cartridge, and a worm from the maternal family is transferred to it. If a large number of queen bees are to be reared, then 20 frame bed hives with two separate bee entrances of the queen family are tightly closed in the middle and divided equally. The queen family is placed in one section of the hive, and a healthy bee family with a young mother bee is transferred to the second section.

In order for the mother bee in the maternal family not to lay many eggs and to lay large eggs, this family is fed with a large amount of honey or sugar syrup. When dense nests are filled with food, there are fewer empty nests for the queen to lay eggs, and as a result, the queen's eggs are heavier and larger.

Conclusion: Half-day-old maggots are transplanted from the nests of these bees to raise queen bees. In order for the mother bee to be of good quality, the method of transfer of maggots is used twice. The rearing family is provided with a rum containing worms from the desired family, and the next day, the worms in the received wax cup are removed and replaced with 12-hour or one-day-old worms from the maternal family with productive indicators in the prepared milk cup again given to the foster family.

UN chief condemns attack on peacekeepers in DR Congo

The UN chief on Saturday condemned an attack which saw eight peacekeepers from the UN Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, or DRC, wounded during clashes between the powerful M23 rebel movement and Government troops.

The incident occurred in the vicinity of Sake, just 20 kilometers from Goma, the provincial capital of North Kivu.

The wounded peacekeepers, who were part of Operation Springbok initiated last November to safeguard civilians in the region, sustained their injuries amidst the ongoing fighting, where UN troops have been assisting Government forces in order to protect vulnerable civilians. In a strongly-worded statement issued by his Spokesperson, UN Secretary-General António Guterres condemned the attack, emphasizing that it could amount to a war crime under international law.

Expressing his wishes for a swift recovery for the injured peacekeepers, he reiterated calls for all armed groups, Congolese and foreign fighters alike, to immediately cease hostilities and engage in the disarmament process.

Furthermore, the UN chief emphasized the necessity for M23 to withdraw entirely from territory it has occupied and conform to the agreements outlined in the Luanda communiqué of November 2022, to uphold the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the DRC.

Bintou Keita, the Special Represent-

tative of the UN Secretary-General in the DRC and head of the UN mission MONUSCO, joined in the condemnation, denouncing the attack. She said that one of the wounded 'blue helmets' had suffered severe injuries and all have been evacuated for appropriate medical care.

The peacekeepers had been deployed for several weeks as part of

Operation Springbok in the restive North Kivu area, working jointly with Government troops in military operations. Ms. Keita reaffirmed MONUSCO's commitment to support investigations in the hopes of bringing those responsible to justice. The Secretary-General and his Special Representative reaffirmed MONUSCO's resolve to further im-

plement its protection of civilians mandate from the Security Council and work alongside Congolese defence and security forces to reinforce joint and unilateral patrols to protect civilians.

Experts laud effectiveness of Chinese democracy, governance

Experts at an international forum on democracy have said that Chinese democracy and governance, characterized by being responsive to people's voices, have proved effective.

On Wednesday, more than 200 guests from home and abroad, including representatives of government departments and international organizations, experts and scholars, discussed topics related to democracy and global governance, both in person or virtually, during the third "International Forum on Democracy: The Shared Human Values" in Beijing.

Stephen Perry, president emeritus of Britain's 48 Group Club, said he believed that China is on its way to a good form of democracy, saying China has a sound system of hearing the people and responding to them. "Chinese leaders do an enormous amount of research into what the people think, feel, experience and want," he said.

The democracy of hearing the people is probably simpler in China

than it is in the West, he added.

Wang Shaoguang, professor emeritus with the Chinese University of Hong Kong, pointed out how Chinese officials go into the masses to learn about their requests.

"In China, officials are required to go to the frontlines, visit the villages and local communities. They share their tables and work, and even live with the people," he said.

Wang summarized this method as sticking to the line of the masses, describing it as a huge advantage of Chinese democracy.

The attendees agreed that in China, the people's expectations are heard by the authorities, but more importantly, they can be realized.

"The greatest advantage of Chinese democracy and governance is that there are no empty promises," said Alexander Lomanov, head of the Center for Asia-Pacific Studies of the Institute of World Economy and International Relations of the Russian Academy of Sciences.

"What is written in government work plans will be implemented," he said, adding that every work plan is adjusted to the needs of the Chinese people.

According to a report published during the forum, nearly 10,000 people surveyed in 2023 in 23

countries, covering Asia, Europe, America, Africa and Oceania, agree strongly with the rich connotations of China's whole-process people's democracy and consider it a benchmark for human political systems. Of those interviewed, 91.4 percent believe that whole-process people's democracy enables the people to voice their needs freely, and that democracy should focus on solving

people's practical problems.

Forum attendees also underlined the importance of respecting the diversity of democratic practice and advocated the spirit of mutual learning.

"Chinese democracy and governance do work, and there's a lot about it we can learn from. We should be studying China, not trying to lecture China," Perry said.

The event was hosted by the Publicity Department of the Communist Party of China Central Committee and the State Council Information Office and co-organized by the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, China Media Group and China International Communications Group.

Haiti gang wars push hunger to worst levels on record

Almost half of Haiti's people are struggling to feed themselves as gang violence spreads across the country, with several areas close to famine, international organizations said on Friday.

Inflation and poor harvests have also helped push Haiti to its worst levels of food insecurity on record, they said.

"Rising hunger is fueling the security crisis that is shattering the country. We need urgent action now - waiting to respond at scale is not an option," Jean-Martin Bauer, the World Food Programme's Haiti director, said.

The Integrated Food Security Phase Classification (IPC) - an organization which sets a scale used by the United Nations and governments to assess hunger - said in a report that about 4.97 million people out of a population of about 11.5 million were facing crisis or worse levels of food insecurity.

Eight areas were now assessed to be

in an emergency phase - the worst level before famine, it said.

These include the Artibonite valley, Haiti's farming heartland, which has been badly hit by gangs expanding from the capital Port-au-Prince, rural parts of the Grand-Anse peninsula and neighborhoods of the capital such as the poor Cite Soleil district.

The Caribbean country has been gripped by violence since rival gangs unleashed a wave of attacks this month, including raids on police stations and the international airport.

The conflict has killed thousands and displaced hundreds of thousands.

Regional leaders are trying to form a transitional council and Prime Minister Ariel Henry has promised to resign once it is set up.

But he is currently stranded abroad, shut out of the country after making a visit to Kenya to discuss the deployment of an international security force. This has now been put on hold.

The WFP said Haiti was now suffering its worst levels of food insecurity on record, with many people resorting to desperate measures and taking on more debt as armed groups take over farmlands and steal crops. The IPC report found only 5% of Haitians had received humanitarian food aid and the WFP said that operations were "woefully under-funded."

More than 30,000 people have fled violence and shortages in the capital in just two weeks this month, according to U.N. data, most of them people who had already lost their homes and were living in camps or with other families.

Authorities in the neighboring Dominican Republic, who have deported tens of thousands of Haitian migrants, have said they have not agreed to an air bridge announced by the U.N. to supply aid to Haiti, saying its air route is for evacuating foreigners.

Laurent Uwumuremyi, who heads aid group Mercy Corps' Haiti arm, said gangs now control nearly 90%

of the capital with basic errands impossible, key infrastructure closed, shortages in basic supplies and hospitals on the brink of collapse.

"Even in areas like Petion-Ville, an upscale neighborhood that until recently has been considered safe, the population has been barricaded indoors," he said.

"If the situation deteriorates without any efforts to address the unfolding humanitarian crisis, Port-au-Prince will soon find itself completely overwhelmed."

King Charles III hails Princess of Wales's courage after cancer news

King Charles III is "so proud of Catherine for her courage" in speaking about her treatment for cancer, Buckingham Palace has said.

The King, who has been diagnosed with cancer himself, is in the "closest contact with his beloved daughter-in-law", a short statement read.

Support has poured in for the princess, who described her diagnosis as a "huge shock" in a video released on Friday.

She has been undergoing preventative chemotherapy since late February.

The princess said it had been an "incredibly tough couple of months" for her family but she was "well and getting stronger every day".

Her news comes six weeks after King Charles paused his public appearances after receiving a following a cancer diagnosis himself.

The two were briefly treated at the London Clinic private hospital at the same time.

Catherine had a planned abdominal surgery there in January, and the King was admitted for a "corrective procedure" for an enlarged prostate.

"His Majesty is 'so proud of Catherine for her courage in speaking as she did,'" Buckingham Palace said.

King Charles and Queen Camilla, who were informed of the news about the princess's health before Friday's announcement, said they would "continue to offer their love and support to the whole family through this difficult time".

The Duke and Duchess of Sussex sent a message saying: "We wish

health and healing for Kate and the family, and hope they are able to do so privately and in peace."

Catherine's brother James Middleton posted a message of support for his sister on Instagram, writing: "Over the years, we have climbed many mountains together. As a family, we will climb this one with you too".

Kensington Palace has not disclosed the type of cancer Catherine has been diagnosed with, but says it is confident she will make a full recovery.

Politicians from across the spectrum have shared messages of sympathy. Prime Minister Rishi Sunak said on Friday that Catherine had shown "tremendous bravery" in the face of "intense scrutiny".

He added: "When it comes to matters of health, like everyone else, she must be afforded the privacy to focus on her treatment and be with her loving family."

Labour leader Sir Keir Starmer said his thoughts were with the Royal Family, and that he was heartened by the princess's optimism and "message of faith and hope".

Sir Keir also referenced the scrutiny Kate had faced in recent weeks, remarking on the "added stress" of receiving her diagnosis amid "lurid speculation".

Meanwhile, US President Joe Biden said he was joining "millions around the world in praying" for Catherine's "full recovery".

French President Emmanuel Macron said the princess's "strength

and resilience inspire us all".

Catherine's video statement explains that when she had abdominal surgery earlier this year, it was not known that there was any cancer.

In January, Kensington Palace announced that the princess had undergone a planned surgery which was not cancer-related and that she would remain in hospital for 10-14 days before continuing her recovery at home.

On Friday, the princess said tests following that operation "found cancer had been present".

"My medical team therefore advised that I should undergo a course of preventative chemotherapy and I am now in the early stages of that treatment," she added.

The 42-year-old said she was think-

ing of all those who have been affected by cancer, adding: "For everyone facing this disease, in whatever form, please do not lose faith or hope. You are not alone."

Catherine and the Prince of Wales are not expected to appear with the Royal Family on Easter Sunday. There will not be any early return to official duties for the princess either. Kensington Palace has also said Prince William's sudden absence from a memorial service on 27 February was because of the discovery of Catherine's cancer diagnosis.

The couple have faced intense public speculation and a social media frenzy about her health - including conspiracy theories - since her operation in January. She has not attended any official events since Christmas.

Earlier in March, the prince and Catherine released a photo of the princess with their three children to mark Mother's Day. The image was later withdrawn by several news agencies over concerns it had been "manipulated", following social media speculation over inconsistencies in its appearance.

Kensington Palace later released a statement from Catherine apologising "for any confusion" over the image, and explaining that she occasionally experiments with photo editing.

While Catherine has stood back from royal duties, William has continued with his constitutional role as head of state, and was recently seen in a virtual address to a service celebrating Commonwealth Day.

Smoke from fire rises above the burning Crocus City Hall concert venue

Russia is observing a day of mourning after at least 133 people were killed on Friday evening in an attack at a packed concert venue in Moscow.

Flags are flying at half mast, many events have been cancelled and TV channels have updated their schedules.

More than 140 people were also injured when gunmen entered the Crocus City Hall, firing indiscriminately before setting it on fire.

The Islamic State (IS) group says it was behind the attack.

On Saturday Amaq, the IS media outlet, posted an image of the four masked men they claimed were involved in the assault. Russia has not commented on the IS claim.

The group later released highly graphic footage from the attack. The video, which has been verified by the BBC as genuine, shows one of the gunmen opening fire

on several people. The BBC will not be broadcasting this video.

Russian President Vladimir Putin has said all four gunmen who carried out the attack have been arrested.

In a televised address on Saturday, Mr Putin condemned the massacre – the deadliest in Russia for nearly 20 years – as a “barbaric terrorist act” and repeated earlier suggestions by Russian security services that the attackers had tried to escape to Ukraine.

Kyiv dismissed the claim that it was in some way involved in the attack as “absurd”.

“To suggest the suspects were heading to Ukraine, would suggest they were stupid or suicidal,” Andriy Yusov, a spokesperson for the Ukrainian military intelligence directorate, told the BBC.

The US National Security Council said it warned Russia of a potential attack on “large gatherings”, including concerts, in Moscow earlier this month. The Kremlin at the time dismissed that as “propaganda” and an attempt by Washington to meddle in the recent Russian election.

On Saturday, the White House said it condemned the “heinous” attack and described IS as “a common terrorist enemy that must be defeated everywhere”.

Reports of a serious attack

inside the Crocus City Hall, in Moscow’s Krasnogorsk suburb, began arriving at around 20:00 local time (17:00 GMT) on Friday.

Up to 6,200 people were gathered there for a Friday night rock concert by veteran band Picnic when the shooting started.

One video posted online showed several men striding across the concourse, where they opened fire at members of the public, before rearming and entering the hall.

Crowds of people were filmed screaming and running in panic as the men burst in. Others were seen taking cover behind their seats as the men fired into the auditorium.

Some of those who tried to escape from the gunmen were thought to have fled to the basement, and others to the roof.

“They were just walking

and gunning down everyone methodically in silence. Sound was echoing and we could not understand what was where,” concertgoer Anastasia Rodionova recalled.

Vitaly, another visitor, saw the attack unfolding from a balcony. “They threw some petrol bombs, everything started burning,” he said.

Outside the hall, huge plumes of smoke filled the sky. A fire was later seen engulfing the hall’s roof and facade. Tass state news agency reported that around a third of the building had been set alight.

Other reports spoke of explosions, the force of which shattered the glass on the top two floors of the structure.
