It's always notable because of what it represents: new faces, new hope, a new start.

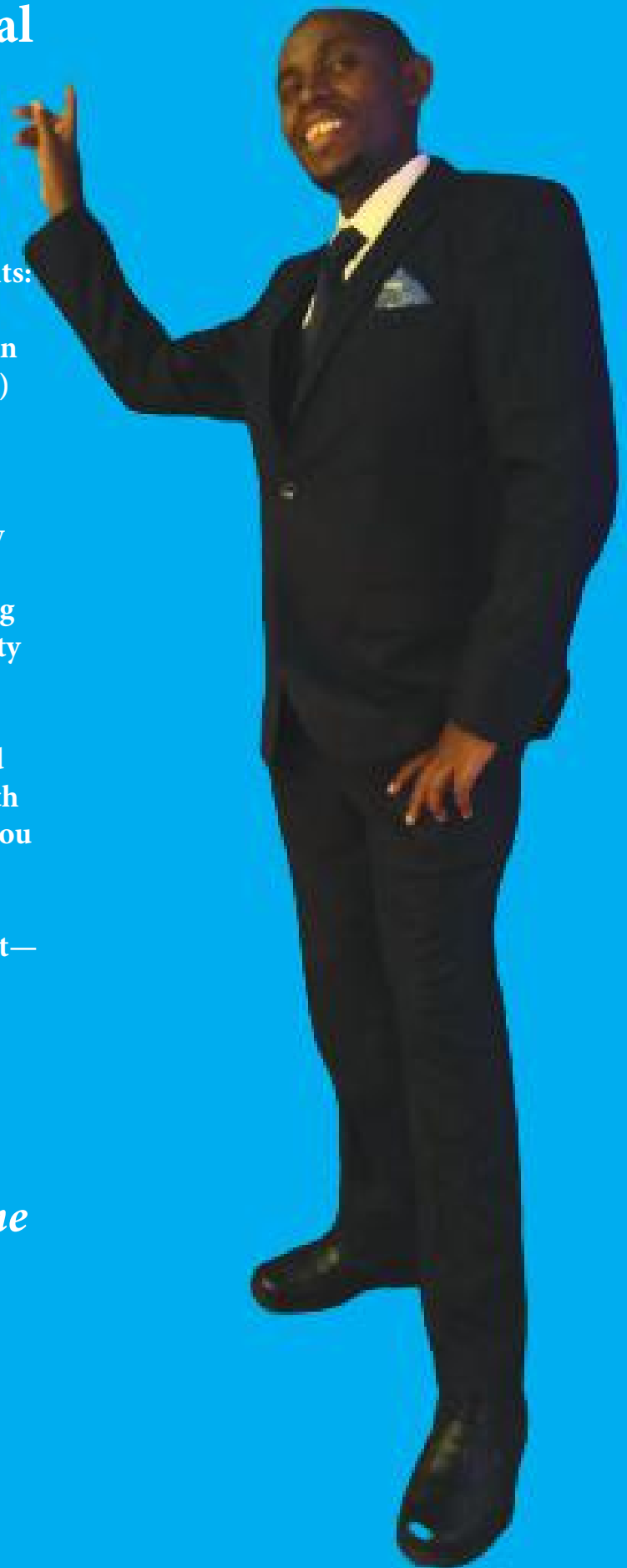

Envy is the mother of all evils

Envy consists of two things: (the first) God Almighty gives a person wealth and the world and gives him the right to own it. he gives wisdom. He bestows (the truth of) knowledge and teaches it (to people).” (Narrated by Imam Bukhari and Muslim)

Envy is a spiritual vice. Envy means wanting the wisdom given to a person to go away from that person. More clearly, and speaking in a bad sense, to wish for the disappearance of a boon bestowed on an individual is to wish for that boon to exist. Some say that envy is not wanting to be blessed, but not being able to see someone else’s success. If you state that you were not jealous a thousand times, even if it is just a little, the feelings of jealousy towards that person will go away. If a person does not like the share in the hands of others, gets angry because of it, whether he wants it or not, he is considered envious. In fact, the dictionary meaning of envy is a feeling of not being able to see something that is unique to someone, something that is related to him, virtue, success and similar high achievements. It is recorded that envy brings five punishments to the envious person: grief will not end, ca-

lamity will not be rewarded, it will bring evil, Allah will be angry with the envious person, and the doors of paradise will be closed for him. Envy is such a feeling that a jealous person gossips about the person he/she is jealous of, gives false testimony to another person even though he/she is not on the topic of a conversation, and provokes.

Satan was jealous of Adam in paradise. Allah, the Most High, announced that he created Adam in a dignified manner and called all the angels to worship him. Moreover, women also receive a wage from their work. (Instead of being envious) ask for the bounty of Allah. Indeed, Allah is All-Knowing.” (Surah An-Nisa’, verse 32)

Indeed, a person receives his share for his hard work. It is not permissible to look at someone’s victories with envy. They were also lucky to achieve many



milestones as a result of working hard and studying day and night. A person should praise and give thanks every second for the sustenance given to him. If we have seen any blessing in someone, we should not look at him with bad intentions, we should not look at someone’s achievement. Instead, let’s thank the Creator and ask him to grant us similar successes and blessings. Our Creator has a wide range, what’s the point of being jealous and wishing someone bad?! As evidence for these thoughts, let’s recall the hadith of the famous companion Abdullah bin Abbas, may Allah be pleased with him: “A person: “I wish I had the wealth of such and

such a person, the wealth of a piston...!”, - don’t dream about it. “ If only I had wealth like so-and-so..! “don’t say. God forbade him from this work, but the servant asks for God’s grace and mercy,” he says.

A woman is the one who shakes the cradle of the world, when pain comes, she finds a claim, sacrifices her life for livelihood and is ready for any hardship. She destroys mountains with her femininity and is ready to gnaw when the stone comes and gnaw when the water comes for her livelihood. There are very few women with such tenacity. However, we see some women wandering around the labor market in order to make a living. They are not less than the weight of working men. As soon as a car comes to labor market, it is not forgotten that women are running in front of the car hitting themselves. They are engaged in such work in order to boil the black pot and make a living. They are doing whatever they want. For example; serving in another person's house, doing laundry or cleaning. True, they are doing dirty work, but they are making a living with courage and honesty. Most of the working women are separated from their husbands and their families are in desperate need of that little money. But if he is the breadwinner and is engaged in this work, his spouse or breadwinner, grown-up child, commits dishonesty and evil by entrusting his livelihood to a child, a cradle rocker.

What causes these women to engage in illegal activities under difficult conditions?

Just unemployment? If we take a deeper look at this issue, we will see that there are other aspects of the problem. I first heard about the women's labor market in 2000. It sounded very ugly to my ears", says one of my acquaintances. Then the women's labor market began to open everywhere. It is an illegal market. Nowadays, this word is becoming commonplace. Because such women are increasing.

There are also dishonest people who cheat women who go to hard work to earn money and do not pay or pay less. In such cases, women return home with an empty bag, tired and sad.

In fact, why are they engaged in labor? In order to find a solution to this question, our journalist Motabar Khushvaktova asked this question to Zamira Mamadaliyevna, who lives in Tashkent region. She has been working as a laborer for 20 years and works in the labor market. She said: „Since I don't have an education, I mow the fields of farmers and help them grow cotton and wheat. They give 10-15 acres of land instead of wages. I grow beans there for a living. Last year, I mowed 2 hectares of a farmer's land and planted beans on the land he gave in return.

But due to lack of water, I earned only 400000 soums. It didn't even cover my expenses". That woman is 55 years old. Divorced with her husband, she has a 10 year old child, she adopted him. It can be seen from these that the maintenance of livelihood is entrusted only to our mother. The reason for this woman's suffering is that she didn't study when she was young and didn't care about education.

Nowadays, you can



see not only elderly women, but also school children and students running towards the car in the labor market. The child is not the only one to blame. It is necessary for his family members to control him and prevent him from doing such black deeds. They are not at the age of making a living or doing menial work, but rather of the age of learning. Of course, neighborhood, school and higher education organizations, women's Committee are not indifferent to this.

To solve the problem, the neighborhood, educational institution, society and most importantly, the family must work together. As long as there are men who take care of the

family irresponsibly and leave their wives to work while they are not working, the topic remains relevant. Therefore, men must do their duty. Not only women, but also men should study, study in schools and institutions of higher education, work in government jobs. It seems that in order to prevent unemployment, we should all get a good education and become useful people for the country.

Dear ones! Don't be indifferent to your own life, your child's life, your family's life! Never stop reading and never get tired!

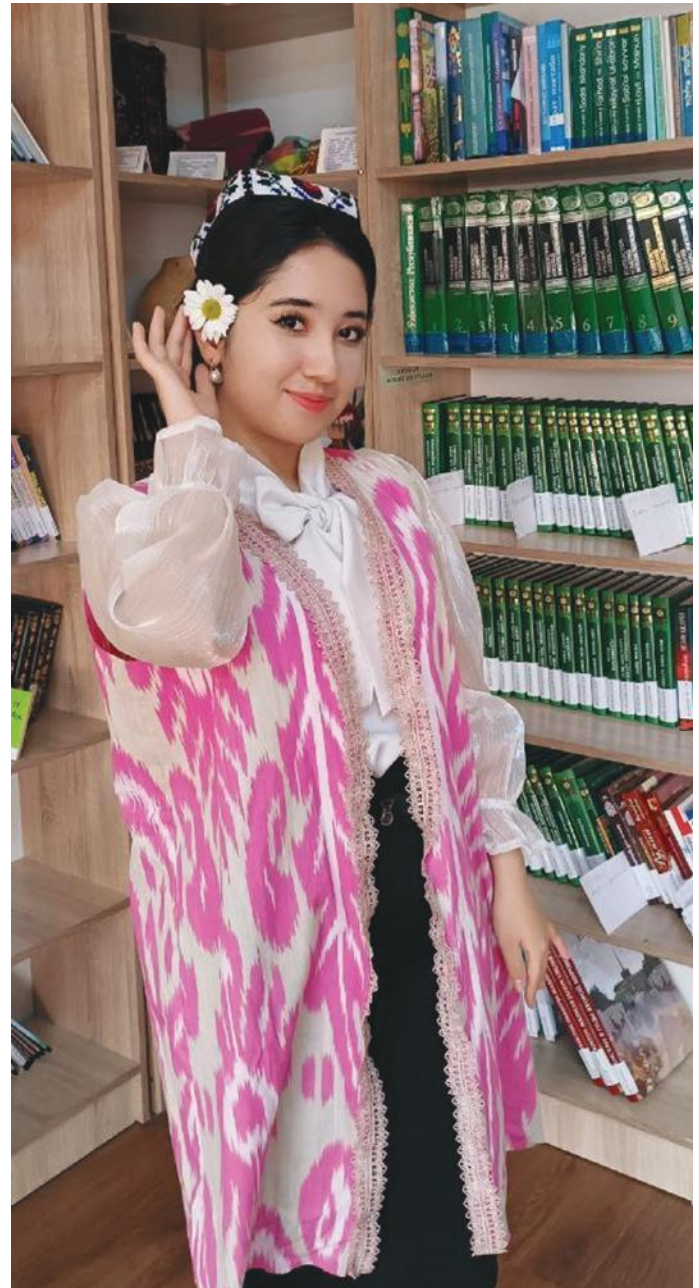

The word psychology is derived from the Greek word and means "soul, soul, mind, character". In order to know the place of psychology in our life, we can learn one of its types, i.e. family psychology, from the psychology of the child. Child psychology is a separate branch of psychology that studies the laws of mental development of a child at different ages, as well as the laws of transition from one age stage to another. Mental development consists of the process of assimilation of the knowledge and experiences that the child has accumulated throughout the history of mankind and the formation of a person. Certain physiological and psychological changes are observed at each stage of mental development. Psychological age reflects the level of mental development of a person and is often called mental age. Mental age types are determined on the basis of special test tasks designed for people of this age. The child perceives the world and the environment through the eyes of parents.
